Nuray Bayraktar worked as an architect at private offices and companies at the years between 1980 and 1990. Between 1990 and 2009 she taught at Gazi University in Ankara. Since 2009, she has been working at Başkent University. She has several articles on housing, urbanization and urban design, published in several books, periodicals and newspapers. She has worked on some social projects and participated in national and international projects on housing and public spaces. She has winning degrees in several social and architectural competitions. She is a member of the Academic Board of

She is the director of the "Architectural Heritage of Housing in Ankara Between the Years 1930 and 1980: Research, Documentation and Developing Conservation Criteria Project" which is developed by Baskent University and supported by Scientific and Technological Research Council of Turkey .She has joined constantly to DOCOMOMO exhibition by some modern housing posters since 2011.

Ece Akay Şumnu, Instructor, Baskent University;

In 2000, she graduated from the Faculty of Arts in Hacettepe University, from the department of sculpture. After graduation, with the dissertation titled as "Searching New Ways of Construction in Sculpture in the Context of Time", and various artworks made under the same title, she took the Master of Fine Arts degree. Now, in the context of her Ph.D. study, in both material and conceptual ways, she is trying to analyze the relationship between form and image throughout the history of art. And, in that respect, in addition to realizing several artworks related with the text art, she is writing a dissertation called "Contemporary Inscriptions: The Relationship Between Text and Form in Sculpture". In general, in her academic and artistic works, she is interested in topics like contemporary art, conceptual art, environmental art, but most importantly text art. And, as a result of these interest, she attended to various national and international exhibitions, manifestation and symposiums. She is the scholar of the "Architectural Heritage of Housing in Ankara Between the Years 1930 and 1980: Research, Documentation and Developing Conservation Criteria Project" which is developed by Baskent University and supported by Scientific and Technological Research Council of Turkey.

SHORT DESCRIPTION /information about installation of the art work, space description, etc./

The poster exhibition which relate a research project which focus on modern housing experience of Ankara, the capital city of Turkey, during the 20th century. Architectural Heritage of Housing in Ankara Between the Years 1930 and 1980: Research, Documentation and Developing Conservation Criteria Project, developed by Baskent University and supported by the Scientific and Technological Research Council of Turkey, aims not only to draw attention to modern architectural products designed for everyday life, but also to develop conservation criteria for 20th century non-canonical architectural products of Turkey. This project's some finds will be presented at poster exhibition. The posters will include some details- names and numbers of apartments, doors and windows, and balcony - of some housing and facade photographs of some buildings.

Ankara, the capital city of Turkey, is the main focus of the study. After the foundation of Republic in 1923, new public buildings were constructed in Ankara, according to the needs of a new social life, which was formed as a result of the modernization program launched by the Republic. Such buildings, which were designed in a modernist manner and are considered to be the mainstream modern buildings in the historiography of modern architecture in Turkey, are mostly conserved. However, modern housing stock, which was designed and constructed whether as single houses or settlements, was neglected. Most of these buildings does not exist any more. The ones that could survive until today, are at risk of demolition. The poster exhibition aims to draw attention some examples of the existing 20th century modern housing and some details of them of Ankara.
